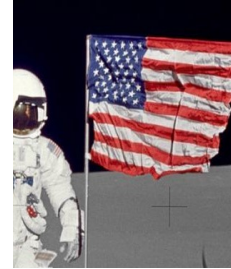


Minutes of the Wyoming County Democratic Committee meeting
